In earlier times it was customary to name the bells of a church or cathedral (Great Tom is Cast). Bellringers would be assigned to a particular bell to learn the ringing pattern. These are the four bells of a group of cathedrals in France about 75 miles southwest of Paris. The singing is said to imitate the sound of the four bells as they ring.
